GOTLAND SHEEP




Gotland sheep originated on the Swedish island of Gotland.

It is believed that Karakul and Romanov sheep were crossed with native landrace sheep to establish this breed. Gotlands are fine-boned animals, of medium size, with naturally short tails. They are known for having a calm, friendly disposition. Ewes average 120-155 pounds, while rams weigh in at 165-190 pounds. Gotland sheep are popular for their lean meat and lustrous wool.
