During your time at VT Grand View Farm, you will participate in a self-guided scavenger hunt that will lead you all around our farm property. You will learn as you go, collecting stickers to put on your scavenger hunt map to keep track of where you have gone. Some of the things you will learn about include:

- Gotland sheep and what makes them so unique and different from other breeds of sheep.
- How we use the wool from our sheep.
- The important role that pigs play on our farm.
- Which plants help keep our sheep healthy.
- How we preserve the natural habitat for birds and insects.
- How our sugaring operation is different from the Buck Family sugaring operation.
- How llamas protect sheep!
- When a llama will spit on YOU and how to avoid being the target for spitting.
- Why our sheep graze in small sections of a field at a time.
