

Terms & Conditions

- We offer non-smoking accommodations.
- Smoking is prohibited in our Farmhouse Suite, on the front porch or in the barns.
- Our hillside farm has steep terrain which prohibits us from being handicap accessible.
- Our Farm Stay is suitable for children, however, parents must be present with their children at all times inside and outside. We are not baby proof.
- Our woodstove may not be used when children are present.
- Pets are not allowed.
- Cooking on an electric pot or fry pan such as hot plates, crock pots, steamers, pressure cookers, gas camp stoves, etc. is not permitted. Please use our outdoor gas grill.
- We ask that you take a Goodling family member with you while visiting our farm animals in the barn or inside of their fenced pastures.
- Check-in is from 2:30 pm to 6:30 pm. Please notify us if you will be arriving after 6:30pm. Check-out is 10:30 am

Rates & Cancellation Policy

- All rates subject to change without notice.
- A deposit of a one night stay is charged upon making your reservation. The balance is charged at check in.
- Cancellation Policy: A two night minimum stay is required. A surcharge may be added for one night stays. Guests departing before final date of reservation will be billed for entire length of reservation. Any additional guests arriving during your stay that were not accounted for at the time of making your reservation will be charged a fee of \$30/person/day. Cancellation Policy Farmstay reservations cancelled 20 days or more prior to arrival date will be refunded less a \$75 processing fee or the entire deposit can be credited to another visit within six months. We do not refund deposits of reservations cancelled less than 20 days prior to arrival.

For your safety and ours we have implemented the following rules:

- Deep cleaning disinfectant routines in our Farmhouse Suite
- Social distancing We will greet you with a smile rather than a handshake and will keep our distance from you. We will not enter into the suite when you are present.
- Masks We ask that you wear a mask when in our presence in a closed space.
- Please be prepared to wear a mask when in stores and restaurants in Vermont. Some places are requiring masks to enter.
- We require proof of Covid 19 vaccination to participate in fiber art classes, on farm workshops or chores conducted inside a closed space.
- As of May 15, 2021, your hosts are FULLY vaccinated!
